Apprenticeship Seminar & Open Day – Invitation For Expressions Of Interest

3. Upon receipt of your initial communication, replies will be sent to each applicant individually, including details of the proposed programme. In the event of an application overrun, consideration will be given to hosting a second event at some future time.
